 - Glass of any kind
 - Light bulbs
 - Paint
 - Plastic film: shopping bags, shrink wrap, packaging materials
 - Oil, anti-freeze and fuel additive containers
 - Pet food bags, juice pouches and disposable coffee cups
 - Electronics
- ⇒ Please do not place hazardous materials in your recycling bin. The Missaukee Conservation District offers a Household Hazardous Waste Collection on the first Saturday in June (depending on available funding). Look for more information at www.missaukeecd.org.

CFL (compact fluorescent) light bulbs, and rechargeable batteries can be taken to the local Home Depot for recycling

Acceptable Materials



Corrugated cardboard, boxboard, brown



Steel cans, metal lids, aluminum cans, trays and foil, scrap metal and wire hangers.

*Please empty and clean.

*No need to remove labels!



Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, hard and soft cover books, office paper, junk mail, manila envelopes (with no lining) and shredded paper

- ◆ Newspapers, Magazines and Office Paper— no need to sort your paper! Just put it all together.
- ◆ Shredded paper
- ◆ Boxboard & Corrugated Cardboard
- ◆ Aluminum
- ◆ Egg Cartons, 1 dozen size
- ◆ Metal of all kinds
- ◆ Large appliances (certificate of Freon removed required if applicable)



Plastic bottles, jugs, jars, tubs, trays and cups—any plastic container 2.5 gallons or less. Lids included! (sort out #1s, #2s and keep remainder together)

*Empty and clean.

*No need to remove labels and lids!
